







# CALL FOR ABSTRACTS:

## Conference on "Intergenerational Inequalities and the Contemporary Family Setup" BIGSSS Bremen 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of November, 2022

How have family structures changed in recent decades? Leaving the parental home early, starting a family of your own, and buying your own home in the foreseeable future after starting work were still part of the typical life course in Germany in the recent past. Today, however, some young adults in many Western European countries are being forced to put off these plans for a variety of reasons.

This scenario opens several relevant questions: How do intergenerational inequalities affect family structures, dynamics, and relationships? How do families respond to these inequalities? How do structural factors (such as gender, ethnicity, class, or age) operate and contribute to those inequalities? What macro-level factors could explain cross-national differences regarding this phenomenon? Similarly, at the micro-level, how do individuals perceive and experience those inequalities? Have values and norms among young people changed in response to changing life courses? For instance, can factors like migration contribute to value changes that further affect the family systems? Do these changing life courses affect social cohesion and welfare state values?

High-quality research projects from **doctoral or post-doctoral researchers** from the field of interdisciplinary social sciences that address these or other relevant dimensions of the topic will be taken under consideration.
